# **Senior Portrait Makeups**

Prestige Portraits will be on campus October 12-15 to take make-up senior portraits. This will be the ONLY opportunity seniors have at the school to have their photos taken, and these will be the photos that will be used in the yearbook for the senior class section. The photographers will also ONLY be taking tux and drape photos (any additional photos you would like to have taken will need to be scheduled at Prestige's studio.) Scheduled times have been shared with students via their school email account. These times have been adjusted from what Prestige mailed to accommodate students when they are at school, so please double check your scheduled time!

#### Senior Meningococcal Vaccine

A 2nd booster dose of Meningococcal vaccine is required for students attending school in NC in the 12th grade. Please review your child's immunization record to see if these vaccines have been given. The original deadline was 30 days from the start of the school year, however, due to Covid-19 it has been extended. A 30-day grace period begins 10/01/2020-10/31/2020. Students that are non-compliant will not be allowed to attend school on or after 11/2/2020 until they are in compliance. If you have questions, call the health department or school nurse. You may reference the original letter for more information.

# NC Countdown to College Month

Activities during the month of October support high school seniors in completing three important college enrollment steps: residency, FAFSA, and applications. What is traditionally called College Application Week has been extended to two weeks this year: October 19 - 30. During these weeks, many NC colleges and universities waive their application fees. #### Spring 2020 COVID (Numerical Grade/PC19) Grade Change Review

All grades for the '19-'20 school year are stored in PowerSchool. To view your student's Spring 2020 final grades, please log into your Power School Parent Portal and complete the following steps:

- Click Grade History
- Click 19-20 school year
- Review your student's F1 final grades

Students received an email with instructions and a link to request a grade change. If they would like to change any of their spring 2020 final grades, from PC to numeric or vice versa, please be sure they complete the google form that was emailed to them. They should complete this form ONLY if they would like to request a CHANGE. If they choose numeric average, they are choosing the higher of T4 or T4/T5 average as their final grade. Remember PC19 is not included in their GPA or rank. The deadline to submit change requests will be 5:00 pm on Tuesday, October 13. Please let your assigned School Counselor know if you have any questions.


