My high school drama teacher was (and still is) an amazing human being that took an insecure teen and encouraged me to find my place in this world. She saw what I could be and that is what I want to give to our students: the courage and confidence to be who they are and to find their own place.

"I continued theatre my first year in college, but left for personal reasons, later going back as an English major. I continued to work in community theatre as an actor, costumer, stage manager, and occasional director. When we moved to North Carolina in 2015, I poured everything I had in

my family and my students as an English teacher here at CHS. I sorely missed the theatre, the people, the atmosphere, the excitement, and even the smells of wood and paint and makeup. Helping out last year with the shows here at CHS fed a part of my soul that had been neglected. Now, moving into this position of teaching drama in a place that I already love, is a dream come true.

"Coming into a program with such a strong foundation and amazing talent, gives an amazing starting place. I look forward to building upon that by strengthening ties within the community and other schools in Union County. It will be exciting to expand the program and giving our students a place to allow their strengths to shine.

Senior Meningococcal Vaccine

A 2nd booster dose of Meningococcal vaccine is required for students attending school in NC in the 12th grade. Please review your child's immunization record to see if these vaccines have been given. The original deadline was 30 days from the start of the school year, however, due to Covid-19 it has been extended. A 30-day grace period begins 10/01/2020-10/31/2020. Students that are non-compliant will not be allowed to attend school on or after 11/2/2020 until they are in compliance. If you have questions, call the health department or school nurse.
