The members of the SbMT work together to implement plans and processes that promote learning, create a safe and effective educational environment, and assist each and every child in reaching their maximum potential. The issues discussed by the Cuthbertson SbMT are varied and wide-reaching. Together we plan how the state and local funding for the school will be spent annually and recommend suggestions to the PTSO for additional school needs.

The team submits requests to the county for on-going capital improvements and decides how to best implement state and county policies within our school. We provide feedback to the staff on activities that parents find helpful in working together and look for new ways to increase the effectiveness of our dedicated teaching staff. We brainstorm better ways of making our school feel focused on the needs of each and every individual. We look for ways of supporting the efforts of the teachers within our homes and the family within the school.

All grades for the '19-'20 school year are stored in PowerSchool. To view your student's Spring 2020 final grades, please log into your Power School Parent Portal and complete the following steps:

- Click Grade History
- Click 19-20 school year
- Review your student's F1 final grades


Students received an email with instructions and a link to request a grade change. If they would like to change any of their spring 2020 final grades, from PC to numeric or vice versa, please be sure they complete the google form that was emailed to them. They should complete this form ONLY if they would like to request a CHANGE. If they choose numeric average, they are choosing the higher of T4 or T4/T5 average as their final grade. Remember PC19 is not included in their GPA or rank. The deadline to submit change requests will be 5:00 pm on Tuesday, October 13th. Please let your assigned School Counselor know if you have any questions.




