Students may sign in to their LEAP account using the Union County Public Library icon on the UCPS Student Startup page with their student number and password of their birth year.




## Say Something Anonymous Reporting System

Last year, North Carolina launched a statewide program to expand school safety efforts. The state joined Sandy Hook Promise to bring the Say Something Anonymous Reporting System to North Carolina schools.

This system is designed to change and save lives by teaching students, educators and administrators how to recognize the signs and signals of those who may be at risk of hurting themselves or others, and to anonymously report this information through a telephone crisis hotline, website or mobile app.

Our school participated in a training on the Say Something Reporting System last week. During the training, students and teachers watched a video that taught students how to report an anonymous tip via the Say Something Anonymous Reporting System.



Thank you to our PTSO and all who donated items for the delightful Halloween goody bags our staff received last week!


