Digital Citizenship Module


All UCPS High School students are required to complete the Digital Citizen Module located in the center of the UCPS Student Startup page by September 30. Please ask your child if they have completed this important task!

During Plan B, students may browse our online Media Center catalog called "Destiny." A link to Destiny is located on their Student Startup page. If they find a book (a real copy of the book – not an Ebook!) that they would like to check out, they can easily place a hold for it within their own Destiny account.

Both Plan B and Plan D students may do this! Plan D students just need to place their hold, then email Mrs. Tautfest to arrange an outside pickup time!

For Plan B students, the book will be pulled for them, wrapped for sanitation, and left on a table for pickup located outside the MC doors. Students will not be allowed in to browse the shelves on their own due to Covid safety measures.

CHS Chapter Chat

This reading incentive program has been created to encourage reading for pleasure, and to inspire book chats among readers and share ideas of great books to read. All students, whether Plan B or Plan D are all welcome to participate!

When they have read a book, they can self-enroll in the Canvas course using this link: https://tinyurl.com/yy2evmuc. Once enrolled all they have to do is click the arrow at the bottom to enter the book's title, author, and number of pages along with a short description of the book. Then they are free to read other students' entries and chat.

Any readers who read over 1000 cumulative pages during the semester will get their names printed on the Chapter Chat academic achievement board displayed in the Media Center and will receive souvenir reader pins! Contact Mrs. Tautfest with any questions.

Calculators

TI-84 calculators are considered basic school supplies for high school students. They are used for all math classes as well as the SAT/ACT. TI-84 calculators can be purchased, new or used, from various vendors for a student to use throughout their educational career.

However, if a student has a financial need and needs to borrow one, our Media Center does have a small supply available for checkout. The new online process for this year is for parents to fill out this Google Form if they wish their student to borrow a calculator for the semester.

The Media Center staff will check the form daily, check out a calculator to the students listed, and hand-deliver it to the student in their Math class. The Calculators should be returned at the end of the semester after exams. More details are found in the Google form.

We hope you are looking forward to the Senior year of high school! We were hoping information regarding the new application and career readiness platform (SCOIR) would be rolled out after the first week of August.

Unfortunately, we were told by the district that this plan was delayed. However, you should have received an invitation to activate your account, along with a tutorial that includes step-by-step instructions.

The image to the left shows the flyer that was just distributed; it contains link information to the UCPS College Readiness page which contains numerous tutorials (for both parents and students) to help you get started with SCOIR and learn about the program's features and functionality.

Please do not request counselor or teacher recommendations in Common App, etc. You may enter your counselor or teacher's name, but do not enter their email address as your recommendations will be submitted through SCOIR.

This video provides helpful SCOIR student application and recommendation information.

As a reminder, official transcripts will not be available to send to colleges and universities until after the 10th day of the school year. This is to allow for the inclusion of all schedule changes, new enrollments and an accurate updated rank. We will announce when you may begin requesting official transcripts.
