Photo Days Coming Up

Underclassmen pictures will be taken next week, September 21-24. Students will take their school pictures on their scheduled class day for the week. These are the only photos that will be used for the yearbook, and due to safety restrictions in place, these are the only dates that

photos will be taken. There will not be a make-up date this year.

Students will be assigned specific times to report to the auditorium for photos in order to ensure social distancing. Counselors will be sharing these scheduled times with students via their school email accounts before the end of the week, and teachers will also have access to these scheduled times in order to remind students throughout the assigned date.

Virtual learners will also take school pictures on September 21-24. Students will be asked to report to school based on their last name, but they will be photographed in the afternoon. Students with last names A-D will have scheduled times on Monday, E-K on Tuesday, L-Q on Wednesday, and R-Z on Thursday. For the safety of all students, all virtual students will be required to complete screening before they will be allowed in the auditorium for photos. 



Chromebook tips – including how to print from your Chromebooks or get past the ZScaler at home – are <u>available here</u>.





Attention Senior Parents!

A 2nd booster dose of Meningococcal vaccine is required for students attending school in NC in the 12th grade. Please review your child's immunization record to see if these vaccines have been given. The original deadline was 30 days from the start of the school year, however, due to Covid-19 it has been extended. A 30-day grace period begins 10/01/2020-10/31/2020. Students that are non-compliant will not

be allowed to attend school on or after 11/2/2020 until they are in compliance. If you have questions, call the health department or school nurse. You may reference the <u>original letter</u> for more information.


