Face to Face Instruction Moving to Two Days

The UCPS Board of Education voted to move forward with the plan to increase face-to-face instruction to two days per week. This plan will be effective beginning Tuesday, September 29. Under the new plan students that currently attend on Monday or Tuesday will be combined to attend both days. Students that currently attend on Wednesday or Thursday will be combined to attend both days. Plan D students will remain on Plan D.

While we will be increasing our number of students on campus, the health and safety of all students and staff members will continue to be our primary focus. We will not sacrifice our expectations regarding social distancing and the wearing of masks. In cases where student capacity exceeds classroom limitations we will look for alternative classroom settings and/or displace students in an equitable manner. While we are planning based on 100% attendance for Plan B, we will make necessary adjustments based on the actual attendance each day. This plan will be fluid as we continue to monitor student attendance over the next several weeks.

We will continue to process temperature checks and COVID-19 screenings in the main entrance of the school for car riders, while bus riders and student drivers will continue to follow their regular routine. Lines will be longer, so we ask for patience as we accommodate double the amount of students each morning.

Attention Senior Parents!

A 2nd booster dose of Meningococcal vaccine is required for students attending school in NC in the 12th grade. Please review your child's immunization record to see if these vaccines have been given. The original deadline was 30 days from the start of the school year, however, due to Covid-19 it has been extended. A 30-day grace period begins 10/01/2020-10/31/2020. Students that are non-compliant will not be allowed to attend school on or after 11/2/2020 until they are in compliance. If you have questions, call the health department or school nurse. 
