Exams

Second semester exams began on Friday, May 27, 2022 and will end on Thursday, June 2. Exams begin promptly at 8:10 a.m. and end at approximately 12:30 p.m. All students taking a course for credit are required to attend the review session and take the exam during this testing window. The schedule for exams is as follows: May 27, 1st block exam. May 31, 2nd block exam. June 1, 3rd block exam. June 2, 4th block exam. May 30 is the Memorial Day holiday. All exams begin at 8:10 a.m. and end at lunchtime. Students will be dismissed after the completion of all exams. Buses will run each day and lunch will be available. June 3 will serve as an exam makeup day. Exam tips: Be on time! Students should be in their testing locations by 8:00 a.m. They will not be admitted to exams once testing has begun. Students will need their laptops and their chargers each day. Seniors should not turn in their chromebooks and chargers until they have completed their exams. All students are encouraged to get a good night's sleep each night and have a healthy breakfast each morning.

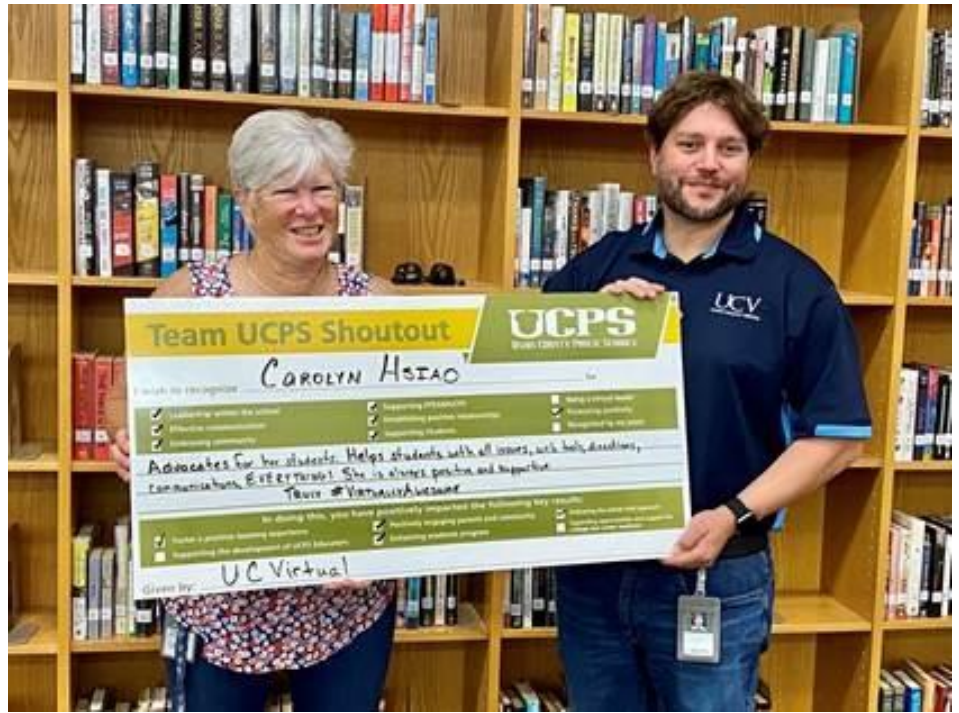

Junior Cavs Basketball Camp Offered

Important message for rising 12th grade students regarding the Meningitis C vaccination requirement

The first dose of Meningococcal vaccine (MCV) was given to this year's Juniors prior to the start of 7th grade as a school required vaccine. North Carolina Immunization Law requires the second dose of MCV for all 12th grade students. If your child does not currently have evidence of the MCV vaccine, please contact your child's health care provider to obtain it. Following administration of the vaccine, please submit a copy of the record to our School Nurse through the Front Office. This documentation must be obtained within 30 days of the start of the 2022-23 school year to meet the school enrollment requirement. Individuals born before 1/1/2003 are exempt from this requirement. Thank you for your timely attention to this matter. 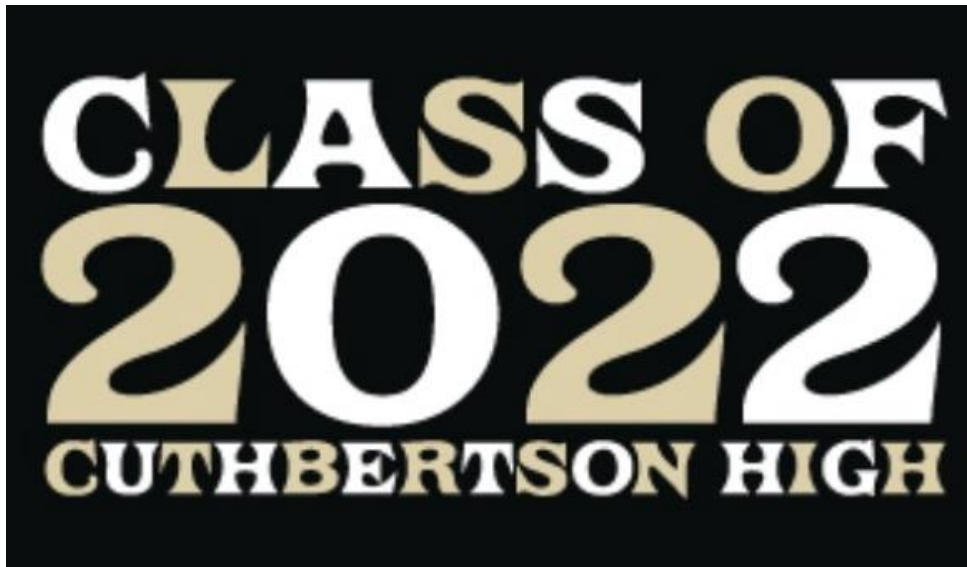

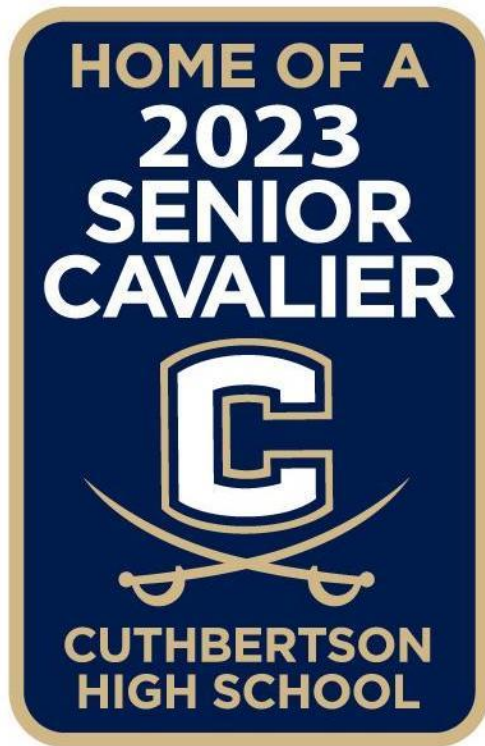
