The 2015 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is now OPEN at www.fafsa.gov

This is the online form that you must fill out in order to be eligible for ANY federally funded need-based grants and/or loans to help pay for college. It is FREE to fill out. If you are attending college next year you should fill it out. You will need your parents' tax information to fill it out, and you should fill it out ASAP! Remind your parents that they should complete and turn in their W2's as soon as possible.

Union County Association of Educators/Retired Educators of Union County

Amount: \$1750

Criteria: Any current senior planning on majoring in education

The N. C. Society of Accountants Scholarship Foundation

Amount: \$600

Criteria: Applicants must be N.C. residents planning to enroll in a N.C. college to gain a degree in Accounting. Applicants should include a recent photograph, two letters of reference, a letter of intent, transcript, and a copy of Federal Income Tax Return.

J.H. McAfee Educational Scholarship

Amount: \$1000

Criteria: This local scholarship is open to students entering a historically black college leading to a B.A., B.S. or A.A. in any educational field of study. Students must have a 2.5 GPA or higher, show a commitment to community service/volunteer experience, be committed to furthering their education and be first-generation college students. Applications include a 300 word essay, three letters of recommendation, and a transcript.

State Employees Association of North Carolina Scholarship Foundation

Amount: Varies

Criteria: Applicants must be the son or daughter of a member of SEANC in order to be eligible for scholarships. There are need based and merit based scholarships available. Merit based scholarships are based on academic performance, financial need, community involvement, personal statement, and recommendations. Need based takes these same things into consideration, as well as financial need. Scholarships are available for 2 year and 4 year colleges in addition to trade and technical schools.

Recipients will be selected based on excellent academic achievement, strong community service involvement, outstanding leadership qualities and essay answers.

Rosa L. Poston and Jeanette B Sherrod Scholarships

Amount: Varies

Criteria: Eligible applicants must be African-American female seniors with at least a 3.0 GPA accepted to and enrolling in the fall at a four-year college. Applicants must demonstrate leadership potential as evidenced by school and community activities. Applications must include two letter of recommendation, transcript, test scores, a 250-word personal statement, and copy of college acceptance letter. Finalists must attend an interview with the Scholarship committee of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority.

Robert Franklin Williams Scholarship

Amount: \$2,500

Criteria: Eligible applicants must be graduating seniors with a 2.8 GPA or higher who plan to attend college or technical school in the 2015-16 school year. Transcript, essay, interview, community service and three letters of recommendation will be considered. Must include recent photograph with application.

John H. Crowder Scholarship

Amount: \$500

Criteria: Applicants should be graduating seniors with a min. 2.5 GPA who will be entering an accredited college or technical school in Fall 2015. In addition to the application, three letters of recommendation, evidence of community service, and knowledge of John H. Crowder's background is required.

A Few Good Men, Inc. Scholarship

Amount: \$500

Criteria: Applicants should be graduating seniors with a min. 2.5 GPA who will be entering an accredited college or technical school in Fall 2015. In addition to the application, three letters of recommendation and evidence of community service is required.

Bob Sabin College Scholarship (formerly Girls on the Run)

Amount: (2) \$1,000 scholarships will be given

Criteria: Any girl who participated in Girls on the Run in grades 3-5 or Girls on Track in grades 6-8 in Union County entering college in the Fall 2015 is eligible to apply for this scholarship. Minimum 3.0 GPA, two letters of recommendation, essay and transcript must be submitted. *All candidates must complete a community service project within this school-year.*

North Carolina Child Support Council Scholarship

Amount: \$1,000

Criteria: One parent must be a member of the NC Child Support Council or a client of the Child Support Program (though either Child Support services or Clerk of Court services); applicants must be a NC resident and a high school senior who has been *accepted* by a 2 or 4 year college or university in North Carolina. Applicants should have maintained a C average during high school (above a 2.0 GPA).

To apply: Applications are available from Ms. Bimson in the Counseling Office. You will need a high school transcript, 2 letters of recommendation, and a copy of your college acceptance letter.

Deadline: April 24, 2015



Gamma Delta Chapter Scholarship

Amount: \$700

Criteria: Applicants should be graduating seniors with a min. 2.5 GPA who have been accepted and will be entering a four year college, community college or technical school in Fall 2015. Applicant must have demonstrated leadership abilities in school, community service, extracurricular activities and/or other activities. Transcript, two letters of recommendation, 350-word essay and completed application are required.

Union County NC Second Amendment Scholarship

Amount: Varies

Criteria: Applicants must be seniors who are US Citizens with a min. 2.5 GPA who have been accepted to a 2-year or 4-year college. Application includes two letters of recommendation, 500 word essay (in APA format), list of high school activities & awards, transcript and copy of college acceptance letter. Applicant must have completed a N.C. Hunter Safety Course.

T.C. Tillman Scholarship Fund

Amount: \$500

Criteria: Any Forest Hills graduating senior planning to attend four year college

NAACP Louisiana Robinson Education & Leadership Scholarship

Amount: Varies

Criteria: Senior applicants must submit transcript, application including essay, cover letter demonstrating community service and service activities performed through school activities, three letters of recommendation and NAACP membership application (with dues or request for financial assistance). One year of active membership by the student is required for scholarship.

Mary Blair Scholarship

Amount: \$500 scholarship

Criteria: This scholarship is for students who are members of a church affiliated with the Union Baptist Association

and who are planning on *enrolling at Wingate University in Fall 2015*.

To apply: Applications available from Ms. Bimson in the Counseling Office Deadline: Postmarked by May 1, 2015 or hand-delivered by May 2, 2015

SECU People Helping People Scholarship

Amount: \$10,000 over 4 years - One student from each NC public high school receives a scholarship!

Criteria: Applicants must have a minimum unweighted 2.5 GPA and be accepted into and planning on attending one of the 17 UNC schools. The recipient of this scholarship should be a student who exemplifies the philosophy of "People Helping People" and demonstrates leadership, integrity, community involvement, and academic achievement. Preference is given to students whose parents, guardians, or family members are public sector employees in North Carolina (i.e. teachers, police officers, etc.).

To apply: Local applications are available with Ms. Bimson in the Counseling Office and must be returned to her in April before the scholarship committee meets. The scholarship committee will determine the scholarship recipient from Forest Hills.

Deadline: Completed application from the selected senior must be postmarked by May 1, 2015



The Charlotte Knights Healthcare Scholarship

Amount: (3) \$1,000 scholarships

Criteria: Must be a senior attending an accredited institution of higher education in the fall of 2015. Must have an *UNWEIGHTED* GPA of at least a 3.3, minimum 1800 on SAT (all 3 tests) or 1200 SAT (CR & M) or 26 on ACT. Must be a member of at least 1 sports team at high school or related extracurricular activity, heavy involvement in the community or volunteer experience and *must declare a major in the Healthcare Field or an interest in pursuing a career in the Healthcare Field.* One letter of recommendation, proof of college acceptance, transcript and application are required. Also includes 250-word essay.

Deadline: May 1, 2015



The Charlotte Knights STEM Scholarship

Amount: (3) \$1,000 scholarships

Criteria: Must be a senior attending an accredited institution of higher education in the fall of 2015. Must have an *UNWEIGHTED* GPA of at least a 3.3, minimum 1800 on SAT (all 3 tests) or 1200 SAT (CR & M) or 26 on ACT. Must be a member of at least 1 sports team at high school or related extracurricular activity, heavy involvement in the community or volunteer experience and *must declare a major within the STEM field* (*Science, Technology, Engineering or Math*) or an interest in pursuing a career in these fields. One letter of recommendation, proof of college acceptance, transcript and application are required. Also includes 250-word essay.

Women for Progress

Amount: Varies

Criteria: Applicants must be planning to attend a 4-year college in Fall 2015. Application includes a transcript, 250-word essay, and recommendation letter from a teacher in a core subject area (Math, Science, English or Social Studies).

Amount: (30) Full scholarships including tuition, books & fees will be awarded
