The 2015 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is now OPEN at www.fafsa.gov

This is the online form that you must fill out in order to be eligible for ANY federally funded need-based grants and/or loans to help pay for college. It is FREE to fill out. If you are attending college next year you should fill it out. You will need your parents' tax information to fill it out, and you should fill it out ASAP! Remind your parents that they should complete and turn in their W2's as soon as possible.

Western Carolina University Endowed Scholarships

Amount: varies

Criteria: Western Carolina University awards many endowed scholarships to incoming freshman. Some are merit-based and some are need-based; if you are applying for need-based scholarships, make sure you complete your FAFSA by March 1. Amount: \$6,000 per year at applicable colleges and universities

Criteria: These scholarships are available to high school seniors who plan to participate in college cooperative education at one of the partner institutions: Clarkson University, SUNY Oswego, Drexel University, University of Cincinnati, Johnson and Wales, University of Mass at Lowell, Rochester Institute of Technology, University of Toledo, Wentworth Institute of Technology or Merrimack College. Applicants must have a min. 3.5 GPA, be accepted to one of the institutions listed above, and complete an essay.

North Carolina Division of Veterans Affairs (NCDVA) Scholarship

Amount: Four-year scholarship at N.C. approved schools

Criteria: Student's parent must meet qualifying criteria. For more information visit:

<u>http://www.doa.nc.gov/vets/benefitslist.aspx?pid=scholarships</u>. Applications must include birth certificates, financial questionnaire, essay, recommendations, transcripts, and disciplinary and attendance records in addition to other items.

UNC-G Guarantee

Amount: Covers the full cost of all unmet need at UNC-G

Criteria: UNCG Guarantee helps in-state students graduate from UNCG in four years with little or no debt as well as provides a support program to encourage academic and personal success. The university will make every attempt to meet the rest of the recipients' financial need through a combination of federal, state, university, and private grants and scholarships. Applicants must be high schools seniors accepted to UNC-Greensboro, received a combined reading/math SAT of 1000 or an ACT composite of 21. You must complete the FAFSA and qualify for federal financial aid.

North Carolina Farm Bureau R. Flake Shaw Scholarship Program

1. Community College Scholarship

Amount: Two scholarships for \$1,000 per year for 2 years will be awarded.

Criteria: Any current high school senior that is going to attend community college to pursue a career in agriculture or an agriculturally related field. Student should demonstrate financial need, satisfactory grades, an evident understanding of the agricultural and/or agribusiness community, and leadership potential. Preference is given to Farm Bureau members.

You will need to complete the scholarship application, including a recent photo of yourself, a high school transcript, your SAT and/or ACT scores, and two letters of recommendation. You will prepare a presentation (video, PowerPoint, brochure, website, or essay) that encourages fellow teens to abstain from underage drinking and driving, or that highlights the dangers of drinking and driving.
