Go to ucps.powerschool/public to begin registration

Students, along with their parents, are expected to register for classes next year online. Chromebooks or personal home computers can be used. Below you will find highlights for student class registration. Please note that counselors will be meeting one-on-one with students to go over the schedules selected to be sure appropriate classes were chosen to meet graduation requirements. Students and parents can obtain Power School log in from the school.

Power School will be open from March 1-15 for students and parents to access the school registration site. On March 15, the registration portion of the site will be locked and for students/parents in effort to process the schedule requests that were entered. The following dates will be schedule review with students.

March 18-19 Counselors will meet with rising Seniors March 20 & 23 Counselors will meet with rising Juniors March 30-31 Counselors will meet with rising Sophomores

March 31- SPCC will be on campus to complete Career and College Promise registration for rising Juniors and Seniors

The following classes require an application for consideration and teacher recommendations. Students must complete the course application, which can be found online on the PWHS website, "For Students" tab and select appropriate application. Only completed applications will be considered. **Application deadline for these classes is March 15th.**

- Media Center Assistant (Juniors and Seniors given preference)
- Teacher Cadet (Seniors given preference)
- Nursing Fundamentals- CNA (Seniors Only)
- Flex Day (Seniors Only)
- Teacher Assistant (Seniors only & Principal selection)
- Yearbook (9th-12th)
- All Advanced Placement (AP) courses (9th-12th)

Points to remember:

- Career and College Promise (SPCC college credit classes) require a 3.0 GPA and a college readiness score on the PLAN, PSAT, SAT or ACT. See Ms. Rape for details.
- **FLEX Day** is for Seniors only. Students should have their graduation requirements completed in their first semester of their Senior year. An application is required and can be found in the counseling center. Application for approval must be made within the first 10 days of the semester. Counselor and Principal approval required after application is submitted.
- Early Graduation is for students who will have all their graduation requirements completed by the end of the first semester of their Senior year. An application is required and can be found in the counseling center. Must be completed within the first 10 days of their Senior year. Counselor review and Principal approval required after application is submitted.
