- PRHS Instruction
 - School Improvement Plan- Basden explained the old goals for PRHS's School Improvement Plan and how they were met with success. He suggested the new goals be: 1. Globalization 2. Innovation 3. Student Achievement. Several members of the site based committee expanded on the goals to place emphasis on: community involvement, using 21st century technology for effective 1- to-1 initiative teaching methods and recognition of excellence for academic performance and graduation. April Dawkins illustrated the formulation of a working document of the various ideas.
 - Staffing- Basden discussed the many changes in PRHS staff this year. He explained that some of the positions are new, while others are staff members changing jobs.
