- Site-Based Operations
 - AdvancED District Accreditation- Basden explained that the timeline for accreditation has been changed this time. It will need to be completed by March 2013.
 - School Level Committees- As previously discussed, committees have been created at the school and county level.
 - Self Assessment/Survey- In April, these were discussed and rated by the school committees. During the May staff meeting (5-9-12), the school will analyze the ratings to help start the process of creating new goals for our new School Improvement Plan.

 - Attendance Recovery- Basden discussed that there was no change.
- PRHS Operations- Technology Spending Model- Dawkins and Basden discussed that this has been a five year plan for PRHS. The county gave PRHS “one time money” to be spent only on technology. The five year plan that started in 2008 included: teacher laptops, Smartboards in every classroom, and updating our technology in the auditorium. The auditorium is getting a long-throw digital projector, and hookups for computers at the stage and sound booth.

 - Student Recognition- Basden discussed that there will be two Awards Assemblies this year. May 23, 2012 will be for underclassmen. It will take place in the morning with a reception afterwards.
