

Union County Public Schools Middle School Basketball/Cheerleader Regulations

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| 1. | The student must have an average of 77 when all grades are averaged together since the beginning of the school year. |
| 2. | The student must have at least an average of satisfactory on conduct for the previous year. |
| 3. | The student must have a physical examination before practice begins and the physical exam must have a one year anniversary date occurring after the end of the basketball/cheerleading season. |
| 4. | The student must have purchased school insurance or have a notarized waiver form on file with the school |
| 5. | The student must have been promoted to the next grade level from the previous year. |
| 6. | The student must have been in attendance at least 85 percent of the previous semester. |

Requirements to Remain on the Basketball/Cheerleading Squad During the Sports Season

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| 1. | The student must maintain a minimum of a 77 average when all grades are averaged together after each grading period. Should the student fail to maintain this average, the student will have until the next progress report to raise the average to 77. Failure to raise the average to 77 will result in the student being removed from the team for the remainder of the season. |
| 2. | The student will maintain at least an average of satisfactory on conduct for the year. |
| 3. | The student must be counted present by the SIMS attendance accounting process on game day in order to play in the game. |
| 4. | Three office referrals for disciplinary problems, an ISS assignment, or a suspension from riding the bus during the sports season will result in a one game suspension. |
| 5. | An out-of-school suspension during the sports season will result in the student being suspended from the team/squad for a minimum of two games. A second out-of-school suspension during the sports season will result in the student being removed from the team/squad for the remainder of the season. |

**Sports season is defined as beginning with the first day of practice (once the team/squad is selected) and lasting through the last game of the schedule.*
