\$25 Annual Technology Fee includes limited Accidental Insurance Coverage

- Fee can be waived if the student qualifies for Free Lunch (parent/guardian must provide letter from Child Nutrition to school)
- Payment options: online @ <http://osp.osmsinc.com/unionNC/>, cash or check made payable to school
- 1st Accidental Incident causing damage is at no cost
- 2nd Accidental Incident causing damage is at no cost
- 3rd Accidental Incident causing damage will be a cost not to exceed \$25.00
- 4th Accidental Incident causing damage will be the cost of the repair
- 5th Accidental Incident causing damage will result in possible loss of computer privileges and/or cost of repair
- Fee due by September 30, 2016
- Accounts must be current to be eligible for insurance
- If Technology Fee is not paid Parents/Guardians are responsible for cost of any damages, including accidental.
- Parents/Guardians are responsible for the cost of lost, stolen, or intentionally damaged devices/repair
