

Student Book Checkout

Students should be able to visit the Media Center for book checkout at least once a week and more if needed. Teachers will typically send students in small groups on a weekly rotation. Parents - please talk to your child's teacher to find out the schedule for when your child can visit. Students also visit the Media Center for classes that may or may not include book checkout (depending on the lesson). Students can keep books for 10 days. If a student is reading a book and has not finished within the 10 days, he or she can ask to renew the book one time.

Book Checkout by Grade Level:

Kindergarten:	2 books at a time
First - Second:	3 books at a time
Third - Fifth:	Up to 5 books at a time (as needed)

Magazines:

Students may also have one magazine out a time and it is included in the number of materials checked out by grade level above.

E-Books:

Students in grades 3-5 are also able to checkout ebooks using their Destiny library account. There are over 500 ebooks available in Destiny. Books will checkout for a period of 5 days and then are returned electronically. Students can log into Destiny to checkout ebooks using their student ID as the username and "student" as the password.

Destiny Accounts:

All students (and parents) can access their Destiny library account online from home or at school. Students in grades 3-5 will be taught by Mrs. Medlin how to use the different features available in Destiny. To access an account use the student ID as the username and "student" as the password.

Overdue Book Notices:

Every six weeks Mrs. Medlin sends home notices for any books overdue by more than 10 days. If you do not receive a notice, then there are no overdue books on your child's account. Students and parents are welcome to contact Mrs. Medlin and can log into a student account to see account information anytime (see Destiny Accounts above for instructions).
