4. Your completed essay (if you wrote on an additional page, please be sure to include it)

All applications must be postmarked by *Thursday, March 4, 2021.*

Winners must be present at their high school awards ceremonies, or the scholarship will be forfeited.

Scholarship checks will be mailed directly to the colleges/universities/community colleges on November 1, *2021.*
