The Waxhaw Woman's Club announces the **2022 Waxhaw Woman's Club Scholarship Award Program**. Under the program, a \$2,500 - \$5,000 scholarship will be awarded to a young woman from the senior class of a Union County, NC public high school.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- * Seeking a young woman from the senior class of a Union County, NC public school.
- * Applicants must use the official application form. Applications must be typed.
- * Applicants must plan to attend a two (2)-year community college or four (4)-year college or university.
- * Applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor on their application attesting they are qualified for this scholarship program.
- * Completed applications **must be postmarked by April 1, 2022**. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted. **Applications MUST be sent to our P.O. Box address. Hand-delivered applications WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

- * Scholarship funds will be disbursed during the month of **August 2022—directly to the college**, not the student. The scholarship funds will be issued to the college or university upon receiving a certificate of enrollment for the fall semester, which includes the Student ID number and Financial Aid Office address.

The applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee and top applicants will need to participate in a personal interview on **Saturday, May 7th, 2022**. All applicants will be notified of award status via email no later than May 8, 2022. Please check your "Spam" folders. Awardee will receive a formal letter in the mail. The scholarship will be awarded **May 17, 2022** during a dinner meeting of the Waxhaw Woman's Club. A formal invitation will be sent and the scholarship winner should plan to attend.
