 4. Submit 3 letters of recommendation including the recommenders contact information and the nature of your relationship.
 - 2 general recommendation letters from a school official or employee
 - 1 recommendation letter from a community service organization/provider
 5. Submit an essay that includes a paragraph about who Louisiana Robinson is and answer the question “How do you plan to give back to the community at the culmination of your college education?”
 - Remember to include your full name on the top page of the essay
 6. If selected, applicants are encouraged to attend the June Branch meeting and the Freedom Fund Banquet in October, schedule permitting.
