

Residency Determination Service (RDS) Reconsideration and Appeal Process

A student may request an appeal within 10 calendar days of determination. After requesting the appeal, the student has 25 days to submit the request with all documentation. There is an option of reconsideration and two types of appeal.

Reconsideration

- Allows student to change info about himself, parents/legal guardians, and/or spouse
- Complete this step if:
 - Incomplete information or missing data
 - Failure to submit required documents on time
- Error while entering information
- ♦ Change in your personal/living situation

RDS Appeal

- 1) Request the RDS Appeal Online (must request within 10 days)
- 2) Submit additional information and documentation about student, parents/legal guardians or spouse to support claim
- 3) Submit appeal request
 - *Additional documentation and appeal request must both be submitted within 25 days
- 4) Answer calls, emails, and/or meet face-to-face (or via technology) to answer any questions and review appeal

SEAA Appeal

- Final administrative step in the residency process
- ♦ Cannot be completed before RDS Appeal
- No additional documentation or information is permitted
- Conducted by a statewide committee comprised of representatives from:
 - ◆ The North Carolina Community College System
 - North Carolina Independent Colleges and Universities
 - ♦ State Education Assistance Authority
 - ♦ The University of North Carolina System
