December and January Scholarship Information

Lyceum Scholarship Program at Clemson University:

Students must be of a high intellectual caliber, as demonstrated through academic achievement and test scores in their high school careers, and must be passionate about ideas, intellectual engagement, and the subject matter of the Lyceum Scholars Program. Students must also apply, and be accepted, to Clemson University. **Amount:** \$10,000. **Deadline:** December 11, 2017. More information and application can be found on the Scholarship page on the School Counseling website.

AXA Achievement Scholarship:

Applicants must be United States citizens or legal residents living or claiming residency in one of the 50 United States, Washington, D.C. or Puerto Rico; be current high school seniors who plan to enroll full-time in an accredited two-year or four-year college or university in the United States for the entire 2018-2019 academic year; and demonstrate ambition and self-drive as evidenced by outstanding achievement in school, community or work-related activities. **Amount:** \$2,500, \$10,000, or \$25,000. **Deadline:** December 15, 2017. GE-Reagan Foundation Scholarship Program:

To be eligible for this scholarship you must demonstrate leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship; have a minimum 3.0 GPA; be a citizen of the U.S.; be a current high school senior attending high school in the U.S.; plan to enroll in a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited four-year college or university. **Amount:** \$10,000/year for 4 years. Totaling \$40,000. **Deadline:** January 4, 2018. More information and application can be found on the Scholarship page on the School Counseling website.

National Beta Scholarship Program:

National Beta will award more than 250 scholarships to deserving 12th grade Beta members. Applicants will need to demonstrate academic excellence, leadership, commendable character, school and community service, and participation in National Beta activities. Members must be registered with the National Office by Nov. 1 of their senior year. **Amount:** \$1,000-\$15,000. **Deadline:** January 25, 2018. Healthcare Leaders Scholarship:

Nurse.org is awarding a \$1,000 scholarship. To be eligible you must have a 3.0 GPA, pursuing a degree related to healthcare, and submit a 600-1000 word essay. **Deadline:** January 29, 2018. Winner will be selected on March 15, 2018. More information and application can be found on the Scholarship page on the School Counseling website.

NHS Scholarship Program:

This application is open to senior NHS members in good standing. \$1.5 million will be distributed among 500 NHS seniors. **Amount:** Varies. **Deadline:** January 30, 2018. More information and application can be found on the Scholarship page on the School Counseling website.
