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Community

Spanning 640 miles, Union County Public Schools serves the educational needs of Union County NC. Located in one of the state's fastest growing areas, the district enjoys a diversified economic base. Currently, the district consists of twelve high schools, ten middle schools and thirty elementary schools utilizing a K–5, 6–8, 9–12 grade-level configuration. The student body is culturally diverse with a population that is 20% Hispanic, 12.1% African American, 56.8% white, and 11% Other.

Cuthbertson High School is a comprehensive four-year public high school enrolling 1937 students in grades 9–12. The school opened in the fall of 2009 and graduated its first senior class in the spring of 2010. Cuthbertson High is accredited by the North Central Association of Secondary Schools and holds membership in the College Board and the National Association for College Admission Counseling.

Curriculum

The academic program is organized on a rotating block schedule. Four credits per semester is the maximum course load; students take four 90 minute classes per day. Classes are semester-long; each class meets daily. The block schedule was instituted in 2009

Advanced Placement Results
