FAFSA Day—February 20 at SPCC

FAFSA Parent Night—Date TBD at Forest Hills High School.

Who: Students planning to attend college (4-yr, 2-yr, or Community College)

What: Federal grants (read: you don't have to pay them back) and federal loan programs that can help you cover the cost of attending college.

When: The form opened up on January 1st and the federal grants are first-come, first-serve... Ready? Set? File!

Where: Apply online at fafsa.gov.

Why: Would you pass up free money? Your family may qualify for federal grant programs to help cover the cost of college.

How to Apply

1. Gather your W-2 and tax information. If you do not have this info for 2015 yet, use your 2014 info to estimate.
2. Go to FAFSA.gov
3. Create a FSA ID and PIN number (username and password) to access your account. You may need to wait until your information is validated to use your FSA ID.
4. Fill out the form.

Note: List all the college you applied to on the FAFSA, **even** if you haven't been accepted yet and **even** if you aren't sure you want to go there.
