

9th-11th: STUDENT/PARENT INSTRUCTIONS FOR 2023-24 REGISTRATION

Dear Parents and Students,

Spring 2023

We are excited to begin the registration process for the 2023-24 school year. SVHS counselors will present Registration information to high school students via a Homeroom presentation on FEBRUARY 22nd. **Online course selections must be entered into Powerschool by Monday, March 6th.** SVHS counselors will begin meeting one-on-one with students to review selections, beginning on March 6th. We hope to complete this process by Spring Break.

STEP ONE: VIEW REGISTRATION PRESENTATION IN HOMEROOM

- ✓ You will view the presentation/power point to get course sequence information
- ✓ Discuss course selection with your teachers and parents
- ✓ Decide on 8 TOP courses (4 core classes and 4 electives) as well as 4 ALTERNATE elective choices.
- ✓ **COMPLETE PAPER REGISTRATION WORKSHEET** with your choices- this will help guide you once you go into PowerSchool to enter your class selections.

If unsure of the level of class (College Prep or Honors) you should register for, please discuss this with your current teacher. Teachers will be submitting recommendations to counselors for core classes to ensure all students are scheduled appropriately.

Remember Pre and Co- Requisites (This information is found in the Program of Studies).

STEP TWO: COMPLETE REGISTRATION IN POWER SCHOOL

Instructions for Student Registration through PowerSchool

1. Student signs in PowerSchool.
2. Click "Class Registration" in the left-hand column.
3. Click the box with a pencil on the right-hand side of the page beside each Course Subject listed to see available courses to choose from.
4. Once you have selected your course(s), click "Okay" and continue down the page and hit submit.

*** Make sure you register for 8 courses and 4 alternate electives.**

UCPS Graduation Requirements- Class of 2024 and later

Content Area	Future-Ready Core	Courses
English	4 credits	English I, II, III, IV
Mathematics	4 credits	Math I, II, III, and a fourth math* Options include: *NC Math 4 * Pre-Calculus Honors * Discrete Math
Science	3 credits	Earth Science, Biology, and a Physical Science* (this can be: * Physical Science * Chemistry OR * Physics
Social Studies	4 credits	World History, Civic Literacy (Civics), American History, Economics and Personal Finance
World Language	2 credits	Not required for graduation, but required for 4 year college admissions
Health/PE	1 credits	Health & PE
Electives	10 credits	Any combination from either Career and Technical Education (CTE), Arts Education, World Languages, JROTC, or Other Academic Subject Area

Please don't forget to use the REGISTRATION WORKSHEET to aid in selection of the correct number of courses and to help with course sequencing.

 - Formal presentation, especially geared towards rising seniors/college applications to begin at 5:30
- **March 6th:** One-on-one student/counselor meetings begin (ask 3rd period teacher for your date and time)
