STUDENT/PARENT INSTRUCTIONS FOR 2021-22 REGISTRATION

Dear Parents and Students.

March 2021

We are excited to begin the registration process for the 2021-22 school year. SVHS counselors will present Registration information to middle school students via a Canvas module on March 1st and students will take home a UCPS Program of Studies, a registration card listing available courses, and this instruction sheet. Online course selections must be entered into both Powerschool and Canvas by Sunday, March 14th. SVHS counselors will begin reviewing student course selections in Power School on Monday, March 15th and will email each student with confirmation of their selections. We hope to complete this process by Spring Break.

<u>IMPORTANT</u>: In addition to selecting courses in Powerschool, students need to complete the Registration form in Canvas indicating what classes they have requested. This serves as a backup in case there are technical challenges with Powerschool- i.e., you can't get your selections to save and submit due to not having your selections in the correct categories.

STEP ONE: COMPLETE PAPER REGISTRATION CARD USING GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

(located on the back of this sheet) AND THE PROGRAM OF STUDIES BOOK.

- ✓ You will select 8 first choice classes by **placing an X** in the box next to your choice.
- ✓ After you have made your first choice selections pick 4 alternate classes that are not core (required) classes. You will need to **place an A** beside your alternate choices.
 - o Be sure you pick alternates that you are truly interested in taking because if your first choice electives do not work out, you will be placed in one of your alternate choices.

If unsure of the level of class (College Prep or Honors) you should register for, please discuss this with your current teacher. Teachers will be submitting recommendations to counselors for core classes to ensure all students are scheduled appropriately:

STEP TWO: COMPLETE REGISTRATION IN POWER SCHOOL AND CANVAS

Instructions for Student Registration through PowerSchool

- 1. Student signs in PowerSchool.
- 2. Click "Class Registration" in the left-hand column.
- 3. Click the box with a pencil on the right-hand side of the page beside each Course Subject listed to see available courses to choose from.
- 4. Once you have selected your course(s), click "Okay" and continue down the page and hit submit.
 - * Make sure you register for 8 courses and 4 alternate electives.
 - ** Please make sure you also make your selections in the Registration Module found in Canvas as a backup.
