### **Mission Statement**

Empowering every student to meet their full potential so they may become knowledgeable, responsible, ethical young adults who are prepared to meet life's challenges and responsibilities.

### **Curriculum**

Comprehensive curriculum includes: honors and college preparatory courses in multiple disciplines, a full range of Advanced Placement courses, a comprehensive world language program, a fine arts department offering courses in visual art, music, and theatre, a health and physical education program, a Marine JROTC program and numerous Career and Technical Education offerings.

### **Graduation Requirements**

Union County Public Schools requires 28 credits for graduation with the maximum capacity of 32 credits available to the student. Two diploma pathways were available to the class of 2021, Future Ready Core and Occupational Preparation (eligibility determined by IEP Team).

Required coursework: English 4 credits - Math 4 credits (one year beyond Math 3) - Social Studies 4 credits (World History, Civics, American History I & II) - Science 3 credits (Earth Science, Biology, and Physical Science or Chemistry or Physics) - Health and Physical Education 1 credit. CPR certification is required for graduation however community service is not.

### **Class Rank**

Class rank is calculated at the conclusion of each semester and is based on the eligible student's cumulative grade point average using only the final course grade.

### **Schedule**

WHS offers block scheduling, four course credits per semester or eight courses per school year.

### **Grading Scale**

Students receive numeric grades on a 100 point scale for each course. Grade point average is calculated on a four point scale (4.0) converted from numeric scores. Honors courses receive a .5 additional quality point while AP courses receive one additional quality point.
