NEW INSTRUCTIONAL PHASE FOR STUDENTS BEGINS APRIL 20

Beginning Monday, April 20, teachers will begin offering new instructional materials to students. In addition, students will be provided with a total of 180 minutes per week per course. This is an increase in instructional materials and support for students in each course from our previous phase. We will continue with the same schedule:

- Monday and Wednesday: 1st and 2nd with 90-minute instructional set for each course
- Tuesday and Thursday: 3rd and 4th with 90-minute instructional set for each course
- Friday: Office Hours as published by each teacher (some teachers have multiple days with office hours)
- Monday-Friday: Counselors and Administrators have office hours throughout each day

- Rocky River Elementary School


- Sardis Elementary School
