#### 2019-2020 School Year

### Monday - March 30, 2020 - Principal's Message

Monday, March 30th, begins our first day of remote learning for high school courses at UCEC due to COVID-19 school closures. I encourage students to check school emails so that you hear from your teachers about the specifics of your online course structure. Please see the general schedule below so that you have an understanding of the general learning schedule students will follow for their coursework. Please know that this is for high school courses only. I also encourage students to check school emails and teacher course pages routinely to access the materials and activities teachers have worked tirelessly to develop, create, and prepare for these remote learning opportunities.

Because remote learning in this broad-scale approach is new to education as a whole, and because we are working on access and connectivity for students as a whole as well, we are beginning slowly with remote learning. We are preparing approximately ninety minutes of instructional materials/activity per course per week. We are presenting this in two 45-minute instructional sets as scheduled for each block (again that schedule is posted below). That equates, of course, to roughly six hours of activity per week. I realize many students and even our teachers are hungry for more, but we are still accounting for children and we want to ease slowly into the novelty of remote learning.

During this transition phase to remote learning, assignments are not required or "graded" in the traditional sense. Teachers will provide instructional feedback, but *grades* (A, B, C, D, and F or numerical) are *not* a part of our remote learning experience at this time. Teachers are already engaging our students quite effectively, but we want no child left behind during any instructional opportunity, and especially during such a stressful time as we are in currently.

As time continues, and we learn more about what the school calendar impact will be longterm, the state and local school officials will direct us on further measures of support we will be able to provide our students. We will continue to update you in those areas as well.

(NOTE: Please know that if a student has one or more college course(s), those are well underway since SPCC resumed classes on March 18, 2020.)

If you have a need, please email any staff member. We stand ready to help you with any concern. There are many resources we can provide for you during this time. We have included many links in this update for you to reference as well. Stay safe and healthy.


