PRINCIPAL MESSAGE -MONDAY, MAY 11, 2020

We have nine days to go in this school year!!! It is both exciting and daunting to think that we will be finishing up the 2019-2020 school year in the next two weeks. What an interesting end-ofyear we have had this year, and wrapping up our year will prove interesting as well. Several details we want to make sure we list here to ensure you are reminded of these as you make plans for ending the school year.

Important Date - May 21, 2020 - This is the last school day of our UCEC School Year for 2019-2020.

GRADING -

Grading for the Class of 2020 -

Students in the Class of 2020 have a grading policy issued by the state and UCPS and that plan has been published since March 27, 2020. We are processing those grades and seniors will be notified through the school data portal, written notification by the school of the ways both type of courses (both high school and CCP) will be represented on their transcripts.

GRADING -

<u>Grading for Grades 9-11 (and non-graduating 12th graders)</u> -Students in grades 9-11 and non-graduating seniors have a grading policy issued by the state and UCPS and that plan has being shared on our webpage, in social media links, and directly via email in Connect-Ed. For students in grades 9-11, students and their parents will receive a notification of grading for the semester and will need to return the signed form that indicates the desire for a numerical grade or a grade of "P" for passing if the student is passing the course. If the circumstances have impacted a student this semester such that the student will not pass a course, the student will be afforded the opportunity to have a "W" recorded for that course rather than a failing grade. The student will then have the opportunity to take the course during the summer (if it is available) or at the first opportunity during the next school year 2020-2021. The "W" will have no impact on the student's GPA on the transcript.

TURN-IN ITEMS FOR THE YEAR -

Computer Laptop Turn-In and Fee Collections -

For students who need to turn in laptops or owe fees for anything (cafeteria, etc.), there are going to be supports for this process. We are publishing the schedule for turning in items during the beginning days of this coming week so families can make plans based on the open times for turn-in. We hope to be able to collect other materials a student may owe back to teachers like textbooks or other classroom equipment/materials. We hope to make that turn-in time the same as our turn-in for laptops.

We will have a day for Class of 2020 and a day for all underclassmen for turn-in days. We will announce the process for each group.

For now, however, we want students to continue to use those materials and equipment to make the most of the instructional time we have left in this school year. Students, please keep working to meet the best level of instructional goals you are able to for the remainder of the year. Parents, we ask that you continue to encourage your child to do the best possible work as grades are being calculated and we hope to improve grades through the work that students have been able to complete during Remote Learning. It is extremely important to complete and submit the work that was assigned during New Learning Phase that starting on April 20 and will continue through the end of the school year which is May 21.


