Principal's Message - May 4, 2020

We are entering a **third week of new instruction and materials** in our Remote Learning process. As we continue with remote learning, I encourage all students to continue to participate in the learning opportunities that teachers are posting twice per week for each class. Teachers are providing feedback to students on all work submitted during this week and the prior weeks.

The state and system leaders are **finalizing grading processes** for our students in grades 9-11 (and non-graduating seniors), and those details will be published in multiple ways once they are finalized. If you have questions after receiving the details of the grading processes for students, please let any teacher or administrator know and we will be happy to help you.

This week is Teacher Appreciation Week! Please take a minute to let teachers know how much you appreciate them! Stiudents are working hard and so are teachers in making sure students are gaining the knowledge and skills in each course this semester. The learning has not stopped with the school building being closed. Teachers and students, we appreciate you and honor the work you do ongoing and especially during this remote learning time.

For **SPCC courses**, those are wrapping up for all students (grades 10-13). Students, please make sure any final details required for the college courses are taken care of prior to the end of the college semester so that instructors can wrap up those courses for you. All college course material will end no later than May 13, 2020.

We will **soon be able to process Driver's Education DEC forms only** and students and parents will need to schedule an appointment for the process. We will publish the schedule and process for that as we are able. These will be issued by appointment only to meet and comply with social distancing and health regulations.

Families, UCPS is committed to continuing the **UCPS Meal program** as long as possible. Please see the information below. We do list this information in every newsletter because we feel it is important to share this tremendous support for any student in UCPS.

For the **Class of 2020**, UCPS has surveyed Class of 2020 families regarding graduation processes for all UCPS-members of the Class of 2020. By now, all students in the Class of 2020 should have received the cap and gown as well as announcements and other items you have ordered through our Jostens' partnership.

We anticipate further direction about graduation and what that will look like for us as soon as the UCPS survey results can be incorporated into the necessary measures we are taking to meet and comply with guidance on social distancing from North Carolina health professionals and the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) with regard to large gatherings. As soon as those directions are received, we will be able to publish a plan for a graduation process for our students in the Class of 2020. **Please stay tuned!**
