 - o Biology EOC had a 96% proficiency, which is up 2.1% from last year.
 - English II was 97.9% proficiency. Last year CATA had one the highest rates at 95.5%
 - Math I was 81.8% up by 4% outstanding growth shown by students.
 - o Math III was 97.6%. Last year was 92.2%
