Students should arrive early (8:00 - 8:15) in order to deliver computers to their exam locations first thing in the morning. Teachers have important setup that must be completed prior to the beginning of exams.

Students are released from exams once all exams have been completed. This is to maintain an appropriate exam environment within the school. This time is variable. We generally find that exams have been completed around 12:45, but this is an approximate time only. Sometimes we're done a little earlier – sometimes a little later.

Buses will run on an exam schedule. This means that students who ride the bus will have the opportunity to eat lunch and then the buses will take them home.

We will dismiss first those students who are car riders and drivers. Then we'll send bus riders for lunch.

Infinite Campus

The North Carolina State Board of Education is moving to a new Student Information System. **Beginning in July 2025**, Union County Public Schools will begin using Infinite Campus. This system will replace PowerSchool for access to grades, attendance, assignments and other important school information.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. Will my PowerSchool parent account username/password transfer to Infinite Campus?

A. No. Parents will need to create a new account with Infinite Campus.

Q. When will parents have access to Infinite Campus?

A. Parents will receive an email in mid to late July with information on how to create an account and then gain access to their student's information.

Q. Will I need an account for each student?

A. Parents will only need one account to see their student's information.

Q. Will students receive a new ID number?

A. No, student ID numbers will not change.

Q. How will parents access the new portal?

A. The Infinite Campus portal can be accessed via a cell phone or computer.

Q. What can parents do to help with the transition?

A. If your contact information has changed this school year, contact your child's school to update your address and contact information.

Q. What happens if my contact information changes this summer?

A. Parents will have the option to change their contact information and emergency contacts when the parent portal opens.

Q. When will more information become available about the parent portal?

A. Parents will receive more details during open houses, back-to-school events and in school newsletters and emails.

PREGUNTAS FRECUENTES

R. Los padres solo necesitarán una cuenta para ver la información de sus estudiantes.

P. Recibirán los estudiantes un nuevo número de identificación?

R. No, los números de identificación de los estudiantes no cambiarán.

P. ¿Cómo accederán los padres al nuevo portal?

R. El portal Infinite Campus se puede acceder desde un teléfono celular o una computadora.

P. ¿Qué pueden hacer los padres para ayudar con la transición?

R. Si su información de contacto ha cambiado este año escolar, comuníquese con la escuela de su hijo/a para actualizar su dirección e información de contacto.

P. ¿Qué pasa si mi información de contacto cambia durante el verano?

R. Los padres tendrán la opción de cambiar su información de contacto y sus contactos de emergencia cuando se abra el portal para padres.

P. ¿Cuándo habrá más información disponible sobre el portal para padres?

R. Los padres recibirán más detalles durante las jornadas de casas abiertas, los eventos de regreso a clases y los boletines y correos electrónicos escolares.

В. Перенесут ли имя пользователя/пароль моей родительской учетной записи PowerSchool в Infinite Campus?

О. Нет. Родителям нужно будет создать новую учетную запись в Infinite Campus.

В. Когда родители получат доступ к Infinite Campus?

О. Родители получат электронное письмо в середине или конце июля с информацией о том, как создать учетную запись и затем получить доступ к информации о своем ребенке.

В. Нужна ли мне будет учетная запись для каждого ученика?

О. Родителям понадобится только одна учетная запись, чтобы видеть информацию о своих детях.

В. Получат ли студенты новый идентификационный номер?

О. Нет, номера студенческих билетов не изменятся.

В. Как родители получают доступ к новому portalу?

О. Доступ к portalу Infinite Campus можно получить с помощью мобильного телефона или компьютера.

В. Что могут сделать родители, чтобы помочь с переходом?

О. Если в этом учебном году ваша контактная информация изменилась, обратитесь в школу вашего ребенка, чтобы обновить адрес и контактную информацию.

В. Что произойдет, если моя контактная информация изменится этим летом?

О. Родители смогут изменить свою контактную информацию и контакты для экстренной помощи, когда откроется родительский портал.

В. Когда появится дополнительная информация о родительском portalе?

О. Родители получат более подробную информацию во время дней открытых дверей, мероприятий, посвященных возвращению в школу, а также в школьных бюллетенях и электронных письмах.

SENIORS – Financial Aid For College

The 2025-2026 FAFSA - Free Application for Federal Student Aid is now open

Create your account at [StudentAid.gov](https://studentaid.gov) - takes 1 to 3 days to process account registration. If you have an account log in.

- Assists students with apply for community college, trade schools, and 4-year universities.
- Types of aid students may be eligible for:
 - Grants – free money, does not have to be paid back
 - Loans – borrowed money, must be paid back
 - Work Study – provides a job paid by the student aid program
- Apply in Senior year for 2025-2026 through <https://studentaid.gov/>.

Here's what you need to know.

1. If you have a weighted GPA of 2.8 or above, you have the opportunity for a simplified application process to the participating NC colleges and universities.
2. To claim your spot, you should scan the QR code on your letter (or the one below!) to visit NCCollegeConnect.org.
3. There you will find a "Claim Your Spot" button that will take you to the NC College Connect portal if you are already logged into your CFNC account. (Tip: If you are not logged in, you will be asked to log in using your CFNC credentials or create a new CFNC account.)
4. After logging in, you will see a list of colleges and universities where you can complete a simplified application for each institution.
5. Once you've submitted your simplified application(s), the college(s) will contact you with more information about next steps.
6. These simplified applications will have fees, possibly ranging from \$30 to \$75. Submit your simplified application during College Application Week (October 21–27, 2024) to avoid application fees for most participating institutions.
