This year, I'm very proud to announce that our students and teachers are **AMAZING** (no surprise there). Overall, our School Performance Grade increased from 74 to 75! Our grade of B keeps getting stronger!
- Parents of 12th grade students: Please pay close attention to the slide in this WPP regarding Senior Night. This Tuesday, 9/17/2024, our counseling department is sponsoring an event that will provide a lot of great information about next steps on the college, career and military route.
- Parents of student drivers: Please note that, according to the Student Parking Application, students are held accountable for their unexcused tardies which also impacts their parking privileges. Since your students drive themselves to school, they are in control of when they arrive. When students reach 3 tardies, they receive a lunch detention. In addition to this, assistant principals will be calling parents to notify them of their students' habitual tardiness. Upon their 6th tardy, students will lose their driving privileges for 5 days. Every increment of 3 tardies beyond 6, students will also lose their driving privileges for 5 days. Please ensure that your students are getting to school and to class on time eerie day. It is also imperative that they leave home on time in order to be able to drive safely to school every day.
