

Site Based Management Committee Meeting - Thursday, April 20th.

I. Meeting called to order at 3:33 by Chairman Gordon.

Mr. Medlin made a motion to approve March minutes - seconded by Ms. Alley.

II. Ms. Gordon talked of the need to move a Risograph copy machine to the 200 building (perhaps from the 600 building)
