School Improvement Plan

- Mrs. Deaton has created a draft of the new school improvement plan. She will share the document with the team for us to review and share any feedback we have.
- Mrs. Deaton will take the new improvement plan to the Principals Meeting to share
- Mid-year- we will talk about how we are progressing towards our goals on the new school improvement plan. Mrs. Deaton explained how we will complete this task.
- As a group we looked at our EOG score data over the past four years. For the past two years we have exceeded the expected growth by the state. We are overall a "C" rated school.

New School Improvement Plan:

- Discussed how subgroups performed last year on EOG.
- Teacher Working condition survey:
 - Highlights:
 - 96.6% teachers we take steps to solve problems
 - 100% feels we use data to help student learning
 - 93% constantly support students
 - 96 % professional learning opportunities are aligned with SIP
 - Areas to Improve:
 - 48.3% parents support teachers, contributing to their success with students
 - 64.3% professional development needs to be differentiated
 - 51.7% class sizes are reasonable
 - 65.5% Teachers have an appropriate level of influence on decision making in this school.
- SBMT Meeting will think of ways we can increase parent involvement in school and student learning.
- Reviewed office referral data from last year.
- We will be named a PBIS Model school again this year. We were nominated last year.
