Early Civilizations unit in 1st grade: One lesson mentions 3 world religions; we are going to leave that lesson out until the county approves it.

Fourth grade: Do 3 of the 4 units, but we chose not to do the Empires & Middle Ages unit since there is information about religions. We won't use unless the county approves it. This grade will use a text already in our library about the Biltmore House which relates to a field trip they are going to take.

No concerns in other grade levels. All CKLA units were approved; team members will sign off on the sheets.

M'lissa Caines: The committee voted to blanket approve all books in the media center. The county has grandfathered in all classroom libraries. Every teacher should always use best judgment with classroom libraries.
