- Have a minimum of five years effective teaching experience, as measured by EVAAS where applicable.
- Demonstrate mastery-level instructional practices as measured by an effectiveness rating of Effective or Highly
- Effective on the NC Educator Evaluation System (NCEES).
- Demonstrate expertise in content, curriculum development, student learning, data analysis, digital learning, and professional development.
- Exhibit experience analyzing and utilizing student data to increase student achievement through specific instructional interventions.
