

### Local Supplement Increase – Classroom Teacher


- Last increase was in 2017

- Projected annual increase for these employees is between \$2,500 \$3,000




### FY 2021 Budget Breakdown All Sources






## FY 2021 State Budget Breakdown






## FY 2021 Local Budget Breakdown




