Results and Academic Plan for East Union - We did not meet most of our academic targets for 2014-2015 school year. Dr. Radke's goal for the school is to improve our academic performance with the guidance of curriculum coordinators and other things that are being put in place. - Dr. Radke is considering modifying the activity time 30 minutes to bring some academic support into that block of time. Mrs. Florentino suggested bringing back clubs that tie to academic skills. - Mrs. Schafer stated that many students need that activity block in the day. At the end of the day many students are restless and have lots of energy to burn. Other teachers suggested that teachers need to implement more activities and things in the classroom to keep students moving. - All attendees agreed on Dr. Radke looking into the possibility of changing unstructured activity time into more academic based activities. Survey Information - Dr. Radke handed out the student, community and staff surveys and told grade level chairs to bring it to their grade level and come up with three goals for each survey. On next site based meeting we will come to a consensus and decide what our school goal is. - When thinking about a goal, Dr. Radke advised all attendees to take into consideration things that we can control and work on here at the school level. New SIP Goal – Advocate for all students - We will strive this year to make sure all of our students are accounted for. We are here for the students and we will have each student make a connection with an adult in the building. - Mrs. Florentino suggested to survey students as to who they relate to. We will do a survey in October. - Mrs. Hill suggested posting class rosters in the 6 th grade workroom for the teachers to look at and write their name next to the student who they believe the teacher has a significant relationship with. This would allow us to see those students who have no known advocate. - There was a concern stated: What happens if one teacher gets lots of students and another teacher gets none? Dr. Radke will look at these on a one to one basis and think about what we can do to help.	Radke	10 minutes
Open Forum - No concerns from 6 th , 7 th or 8 th grade. - Related Arts reps (Mrs. Florentino) Just stated that on October 21 st will be the school performance and October 22 nd will be the evening event. - Mrs. Plue asked Dr. Radke for some clarification on whether or not students can wear open toed shoes. Dr. Radke explained that she wasn't against open toed shoes but this would require a process in which all stakeholders will have a say in order to change the current policy. Site based committee decided that there is no need to change policy in regards to open toed shoes so the current dress code remains as written. - No concerns from administration, EC department.
