AdvancEd

AdvancEd has been finished and submitted. District accreditation, not school. AdvancEd will be in the district in April (3 days). About 10 schools will get a visit. If they visit, they will interview groups of people: teacher, students, parents, etc. They will be here for a day and learn about what we are doing here; what we are focusing on. We have completed a self assessment: 7 standards listed from last meeting—narratives and evidences. We won't know who's getting visits until they come into town.

Jacket Time

Want to know what students are saying about Jacket Time. Brought about because people were not taking IR seriously. Not going to IR when they were supposed to; not going to assigned areas when they had IR passes. We narrowed it down to several options, went back to constituent groups and got feedback. No real consensus; no clear winner. Some groups didn't have clear answers; some came back as split between options. Narrowed it down to two options and decided which option was the best. Option chosen was the study hall option. Feedback: Some teachers were already doing that, there's always something that all students could be using that for. Talked about doing it for six weeks and see how it goes. Didn't think that would be a good option because we want all to be committed to this option. Then we can re-evaluate: Keep it, go back; if necessary, change it. Already the STEAM team is thinking about how to tie the incentive program into the Jacket Program, etc.

This will be on the agenda for next month (1) How do we think the current iteration is going and (2) what are some ideas to either enhance the current Jacket Time or move back to IR in the Fall. We will compile a list over the next couple of months and have a clear idea of what we want to do by May.

Student with club passes should get a club pass from the advisor and show to the appropriate teacher for that day. For the most part, teachers should be letting students go to their meeting.

We're going to hold class meetings during Jacket Time in a couple of weeks.

Students need to go to their academic class meeting on the proper day, so if you have a combined class, different students will be going out on different days.

Time should be used as a study hall...catching up on work, could be supplemental material. It should not be used as instruction with new fresh material.

Student perspective...students complain in the halls but they aren't really and completely upset.
